- In January the RFL hosted 3 programs (RVS Classroom visit and Winter Sports program readings) and meeting space for 1 meeting (Adult Book Club). Attendance in these events included 26 children and 12 adults.
- We were able to get setup with ABLE library to again circulate rotating collections of large print reading materials in the RFL. It's been a few years since we were able to work with them and offer a similar service.

Miscellaneous

- Lisa Mercurio began orientation as the Assistant director and working the circulation desk in January.
- Debra Rogler has been coming in almost weekly and preparing our realia collection for circulation. We expect to have the catalog binder prepared for Town Meeting day.

 propose we consider implementing a couple of small projects in the near future. My
 suggestions would include: the creation of a gift to honor Joan Leary's service; a
 portrait project of past RFL librarians; a display board of current RFL mission

 spaces in the RFL (in conjunction with the realia project).

January by the numbers **Roxbury Free Library**

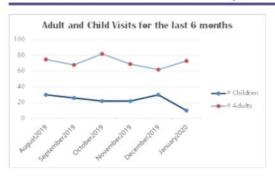
Highlights for January 2020 would be that we circulated the 2nd highest number of e-materials as we have since 2011 (May 2017 saw 98 e-material circulations compared to January's 82). Despite having more adult visits last month than in Dec., we saw only a 1/3 as many children in that same time frame resulting in an overall decline in visitation between the months.

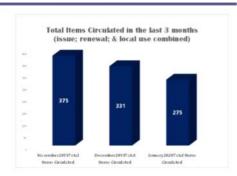

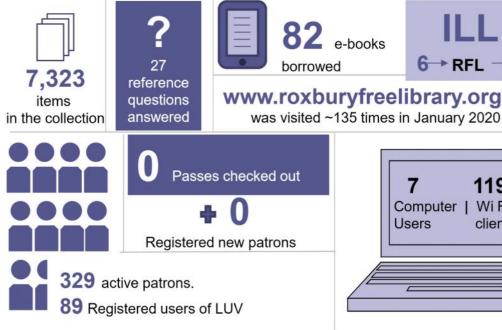

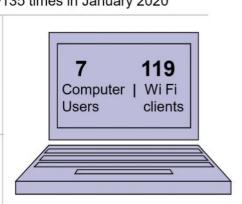
