February Outreach

- In February the RFL hosted 3 programs and meeting space for 0 events (Adult Book Club, Planetarium Show, and CVCOA Online Protection program.). Attendance in these events included 29 adults and 12 children.
- The website overhaul will be a priority over the remainder of March. To date, we have a mobile ready design that the focus group seems to be largely happy with. We will be finalizing the organizational structure of site content, and then we'll get into the aesthetic components for the final product. The designer we've worked with has been great, and the feedback we got from the focus group should help us put together a good update to the existing site.
- In February we delivered 15 books to patrons in their homes.

Miscellaneous

- Caitlyn concluded the course in cataloging sponsored by the VTDOL she had been taking.
- I will be preparing and submitting our Annual Report to the VTDOL this month. We normally submit it in the fall, but VTDOL staff postponed it this year.
- I don't have any updates on any of the steps we've pursued regarding the community support network. Susan D'Amico and I have been waiting on maps from the regional planning commission, and a meeting with the Norwich Univ. community outreach coordinator was postponed from a late Feb. date.
- RFL COVID-19 Review
 - Assuming nothing changes in terms of recommendations from the State or Federal governments, and that the RFL board is not looking for more information, I will likely conclude providing monthly COVID operational updates since for the last 6 months we have not had any real changes to how we're operating.

February by the numbers Roxbury Free Library


