

Satcowitz, Holiday Ornament Crafting, Roxbury Toy Swap, RVS Classroom visits, and Roxbury Democractic Party Meeting). Attendance in these events included 41 adults and 29 children.

Miscellaneous

- I expect to meet with the core group organizing the RFL's 90th celebrations the 3rd week in Jan. If anyone has any suggestions or wishes to see something happen throughout the year, please let us know.
- The RFL FY23 metrics were compiled and submitted to the VTDOL for their effort to annually report out public library statistics each year.
- I met with Amy Barrett and we had identified two areas to focus our efforts on community literacy initiatives. The first is to simply build an active program around the VHC Vt Reads program. We will start by proposing the RFL Book Club put that on their reading agenda. The second is recruiting volunteers to create a replica program to Everybody Wins at RVS. The program is a mentor-based initiative that pairs students with community members to share lunch and stories.


