May Outreach

- In May the RFL hosted 6 programs and meeting space for 9 events (RFL Game Night, Adult Book Club, RFL Coffee House and Therapy dog visits at RVS). Attendance in these events included 31 adults and 56 children.
- We upgraded the Wifi network on the interior of the building to be capable of supporting the full speed of the internet available with the fiber connection in the building. We expect to get the equipment covering the area around parking lot upgraded in the next month or so. Please note, the numbers reported each month on the number of clients and data usage on the public Wifi network are not complete and accurate in this month's report as a result of that equipment upgrade. We will figure out a reporting metric with the new equipment to continue sharing how that service is used.
- We have been in contact with the Brookfield Public Library about the coordinating a joint-program at the West Brookfield Meeting House sometime this summer. We are in conversation with the VT. Astronomical Society about a community event and I'm unsure at this point if those two opportunities will overlap or not.
- Ryan has been working with a couple other community members on one of the VCRD task forces work related to Roxbury neighborhoods.

Miscellaneous

- Note on the RFL facilities following the water damage: We had an adjustor provide an estimate
 to replace the floorboards in the office area and the insurance company approved that amount of
 repair work. We have not lined up a contractor to complete that work but are working on it. We
 have a plan with Gillespie that is up to code and results in a better scenario than the previous
 setup for the hot water heater in the kitchen, however it has not been installed yet.
- We finalized our expenditures for the FY25 and project concluding the fiscal year with a trivial surplus (<\$50). (The RFL now has a small submersible pump on site.)

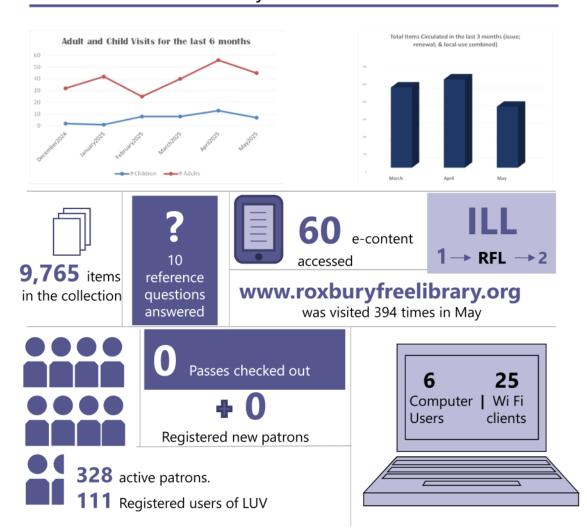

Roxbury Free Library Building Use Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to set clear guidelines regarding the use of the Roxbury Free Library facilities for events that are not initiated by RFL staff or trustees.

Use of Library Space

- 1. The library is available for occasional meetings of local civic, educational or cultural groups. Application for the use of the space should be made to the library director. Any group using the library will be responsible for cleaning up after the meeting, including removing trash, and will be out of the library by 11 p.m. All meetings or programs must be free, non-profit, and open to the public. Scheduling of the library space is at the discretion of the library director.
- Publicity and exhibits by organizations such as those described above may be displayed in the library with the permission of the Library Director.
